

Nursery School registration for the 2025/26 school year will begin in November.

Making friends on the playground, painting, dressing up and building with blocks are just some of the fun activities the children can look forward to.

The GC Community Church Nursery School provides children with a quality educational program which inspires them to create, discover and achieve; fosters self-awareness and self-esteem; teaches them to treat others with gentleness, respect, compassion and generosity; and prepares them for advancement to the next level of learning.

Classrooms are set up to encourage free exploration, with a wide variety of materials and activities that are fun and interactive, and experiences that stimulate all of their senses. Programs are offered for 2, 3 & 4 year olds.

We have added some wonderful Enrichment programs to complement our Nursery Pre-K program. Enrichment classes include Community Cooking, Great American Artists, Science Explorers Class & Lunch Bunch.

We also offer two programs for 2-year-olds, PlaySchool – a gentle separation program, and Next Steps – a drop-off/pick-up program for older 2's.

"This is the BEST DAY EVER!" I shouted to the sun and sparkling water.

My husband Tom and I had rented a boat in our favorite waterfront village and went to our favorite lake spot that we had all to ourselves on a perfect summer day. It was magic – we anchored and swam with our favorite music in crystal clear water.

Best. Day. Ever! What a gift. What a memory. Together.

Perfect days and perfect moments – it is too easy to take them for granted. But our amazing God fills our lives with them, leading us beside still waters, restoring our souls, delighting us with beauty, love, friendship, joy.

In the moment, I yearn for those times to last forever, knowing they are fleeting. Too soon, it feels like they are forgotten in the press of life's demands.



They are like money in the bank that you don't know about, or like perfect fruit that surprises you unexpectedly out of season.

Seven years after our crystal water perfect day, Tom was home and bedridden after months in ICU and rehab. We knew we didn't have much time. We were trying to hold on to our shared life as long as we could.

I looked at him and asked, "Remember that day? How perfect it was? It was one of our best days ever." And he lit up with the memory and said something funny I had forgotten. We started drawing down our bank of Best Days Ever – laughing with tears and sharing our life. The memories carried us for weeks – one at a time.

What a gift. What a sweet, sweet joy in a time we badly needed it. We felt God's presence. They are His memories too. He created it all. He was orchestrating it all.

So drink deep of your best days, and best moments. Cherish them in your heart and keep them safe. They will stay there until you need them. Invest in more. Listen to the Spirit – do something you know in your heart someone will love. Even if it isn't perfect, the memories are.

Then draw them out when they are needed - from your beloved, your grandmother, your best colleague, your child, your best friend. You all are blessed and rich beyond measure in these gifts - together - wrapped in the restoring and timeless love of the Creator of all things who holds all our days forever.
