Pastor's Message

"Return to the Lord, your God, for God is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, abounding in steadfast love." Joel 2:13

In the English language, the special season before Easter is called "Lent." The word comes from the "lengthening" of daylight hours as we progress from the darkness of winter to the new light of spring. But other languages, such as Spanish, have a name for this season that is derived from the word for forty. It is the season of the forty days. Lent is not just about "giving up something" - it is about improving our own spiritual nutrition. Below are some of the opportunities available to enhance our spiritual lives.

Researching Lenten opportunities, I discovered that the first time Amazing Grace was sung it accompanied the author, Rev. John Newton at his New Year's Day sermon January 1773.

Two hundred fifty years later, we are still singing this hymn as a way to acknowledge our own journey with Jesus. Theologian Michael Hoy was inspired by Rev. Newton's words in the Lenten Devotion dedicated to the hymn Amazing Grace. You are encouraged to pick up the devotional booklet when you come to church and spend quite time reading the reflections and entering a sacred time of Prayer.

Our <u>Lenten Book Study</u> will be an in-depth study using renown Pastor Adam Hamilton's book, *The Lord's Prayer, The Meaning and Power of the Prayer Jesus Taught*. Sometimes we need to pause and reflect on the prayers we say in our head and not our heart. Join us for the Sundays in Lent to be awaken and inspired by this prayer.

Rev. Candace Whitman (who was raised at Garden City Community Church) will be leading the <u>Lenten Retreat</u> using the artwork by Rembrandt, "The Return of the Prodigal Son" as the focal point. Guided by Rembrandt's painting of Jesus' parable in Luke 15:11-32, we will explore the biblical themes of repentance and forgiveness to deepen our experience of this holy season.

Frank will once again provide <u>Choral Meditations</u> every Friday of Lent linking us to exceptional pieces of music around the world.

Tara, Katie and Amanda have wonderful programs for children to help them understand the meaning of Lent and Easter.

Carefully go through this newsletter and find ways to enhance our spirituality, and opportunities to serve others.

To the congregation,






